Brad gets lost when he drives the family to an ancient Mayan pyramid. Catherine's anger at his absence boils over as they're confronted by the poverty outside their resort.

Brad returns to Boston to learn his schedule's been cleared to place him on leave while Webb tries to defend Brad from Sam's wife's lawsuit.

With time on his hands, Brad takes Grace on a college tour, delighted by her premed plans while wondering how he'll pay for school.

Tensions come to a peak after Brad spends fruitless time trying to save his job. Catherine finally agrees that Brad has no choice but to take the job in Mexico.

Brad makes a last ditch attempt to round up support from his team and finds most putting their careers before him, leaving him bitter as he boards the plane.

+ Brad's plans are delayed / surgical success

>< Tries to get away / obligation to friend stops him

+ Surgical success ends in first OR fatality

>< Master of OR defeated by fate/God

- + Sorrow/Guilt relieved in greenhouse safe space

>< Struggle for professional distance w friend/patient

+ - Hope for R&R crushed by loss of best friend.

>< Dog's death presents new hurdle to clear w wife

- + Despair turns to confidence after talk applause

>< Brad blows Carlos off, worries about missed opp.

+ - Hopes for a happy wife fade fast

>< Family reunion turns to feud

- + Brad's devastated, then touched by Webb going to bat for him.

>< Bureaucracy bars Brad's return to work

+ - Moved by Grace's interest in med, but how to pay?

>< Support daughter's dream without \$ to do so

- + Fights w Catherine over leaving end w respect for Brad's sacrifice

>< Same

+ - Optimism over friends ends in disappointment

>< Efforts for peer support are fruitless

Carlos impresses Brad with a tour of the center's public programs, & vows him with Brad's own mature corpse flower in Brad's private greenhouse.

As a Catholic doctor, Miguel renews Sam's science/faith debate with Brad, with revelations about the center's paid donors that take the bloom off of Brad's job.

Brad rediscovers his roots training Rosa & Miguel and enjoys access to cash without bureaucratic bullshit as he builds his own transplant program.

Brad comes home to find Catherine tending his greenhouse. She finds his return to the roots of his work has rekindled her love for the man she married.

Brad visits Web at home and is touched by his care for his disabled daughter, but is alarmed by the stress his divorced friend suffers from caring for her alone.

Brad returns to Mexico to perform a transplant on Carlos' uncle, Ramon, but becomes uneasy when Miguel reveals Ramon's crimes as a cartel member.

At a celebratory dinner for Brad, Brad is heartened by the tearful thanks of Ramon's wife but stung by their contrast with the bitter tears of Kay Kinney.

Brad questions Carlos about cartel ties, Carlos reminds him Boston General contacted him. Webb confirms his vetting of the center, but promises to dig deeper.

Miguel's deteriorating performance prompts his confession to Brad about the murder of donors that supplies many of the organs for their program.

Brad drives to the airport in the middle of the night, intent on escaping the cartel, but is stopped by the police who find a load of planted fentanyl in his car.

>< Brad keeps his distance while Carlos tries to win him

+ - Enjoyment over teaching sours w God talk

>< Brad preaches science, Miguel preaches God

- + Struggle w new job give way to joy in teaching

>< Ease @ new center inspires anger over Bos. General

+ - Rekindled marriage sparks sorrow over leaving

>< Struggle between new love & leaving again

- + Sad at Webb' distress, glad to repay friendship

>< Efforts to help are subtly rebuffed by Webb

+ - Ready to dive into work, distraught about patient

>< Duty as a healer vs. nature of man saved

- + Sorrow over Kay's tears, hope for future outcomes

>< Tries to accept congrats while feeling unworthy

+ - Suspicion about employer, calmed by Webb

>< Wants new job to work, gut feeling warns him

- + Horror over program galvanizes resolve to act

>< Pride over time invested clashes with what it was for

+ - Glad to flee, shock of capture

>< Brad's agency hits brick wall of prison cell

Brutal interrogations reveal the hostile world Brad can't call home. He vacillates between strengthening his resolve and the despair that temps appeals to Sam's God.

Brad is "rescued" by Carlos to be taken to his compound to recover. On the ride there he learns how skillfully he's been blackmailed into returning to work for the cartel.

Brad presents a plan to Carlos to end costly murders by running clinics to build a donor database to offer organ pay. Carlos agrees & shares his hopes for legit cartel.

Back at work, Miguel is gone. One night, Brad stops Rosa's rapist with a hypo of sux, then watches in horror as Carlos has Luis use the same drug to kill the man.

In the greenhouse, Carlos shares stories of Rosa's brutal past & his own that made him put family first at all costs. Tells Brad he's earned a trip home, but must recruit others.

Luis plays bad-cop to Carlos' good, takes Brad to a tiny room & plays a recording of Miguel being tortured to death, then reveals his sux murder of Brad's dog.

Fearing for his family, Brad goes to Webb, revealing the cartel's plan. Webb tells Brad to recruit from his team and Webb will deny approval when time comes.

A Maine island kayak trip evokes fond memories of both Brad and Grace's childhood and hopes for Grace's future, but also reveals how much Brad has to lose.

After making love with his wife in their Maine cabin, Brad is tempted to reveal all, but his worry over his family's safety keeps him silent, so Catherine is too.

Brad is in car chase, thinking it's cartel, but is overtaken by DEA agents who've tapped Webb's phone. They reveal he's a cartel mole and solicit Brad's help.

>< Brad vs his nature and Sam's

+ - Relief at survival gives way to knowledge of its cost

>< Battle between abhorrence & respect for Carlos

- + Helplessness gives way to plan for salvation

>< Doing business with the devil

+ - Hero watches foe murdered

>< Rescue vs. murder

- + Horror over actions turns to respect for motivation

>< Love of family vs love of mankind

+ - Relief at going home, horror at realization its not safe

>< Brad against unmasked evil side of cartel

- + Fear over entrapping others relieved by Webb

>< Protecting family vs sacrificing former friends

+ - Joy over daughter, sorrow over losing time w her

>< Ease of early years vs predicament now

- + Pain over lost wife, solace over her safety

>< Can't explain his love for C = their love's end

+ - Relief in Webb's support, revelation of betrayal

>< Car vs car, friend vs "friend"

Brad starts his work as an agent for the DEA, wondering all the time as he tries to gather evidence if Carlos might suspect his duplicity.

Carlos shares disappointment over Brad's failure to deliver recruits, & that partners wanted to kill Brad. Rosa's rescue saved Brad, but now he must deliver.

Carlos compels Brad to start transplant trials with locals. The first procedure with a poorly trained anesthesiologist ends with Brad's second OR death.

Late one night, Rosa catches Brad copying clinic computer files onto a tiny hard drive. Brad makes a plea for her silence, but has no idea if she'll tell.

The strain of his double life finds Brad manically gardening, inspiring the childhood memory of Sam that reveals the limits of Brad's power to control his fate.

Carlos enters greenhouse to reveal plan to scale new biz with murders, blackmails Brad to recruit help with photos of Grace the same evening corpse flower blooms.

Brad is sent home to round up recruits, finds Webb on vacation, Grace at college, Catherine filing for divorce. He visits greenhouse alone to deadhead dead flowers.

Brad skips plane for last visit with Grace, but heads north when spotting a tail. Knowing he'll never see family again, his car turns into woods before crash into sea.

A new face greets Brad after plastic surgery for his new life serving poor patients in witness protection program. Learns cartel is busted, Webb arrested, Carlos got away.

Brad attends Grace's graduation, hears of med school, sees Catherine w beau, thinks about his new life serving poor patients, leaves rose on Grace's car.

- + Double-agent terror, hope at pulling it off

>< Brad vs. the cartel & his doubts about spying

+ - Belief he's duping Carlos ends in fear about future

>< Spy vs. spy, who knows what about who?

- + Sting of death underscores Brad's power to prevent it when he's in charge

>< Competence vs incompetence

+ - Key data is in hand at moment Brad is caught

>< Inscrutable Rosa = no answers about B's safety

- + Revelation about limits of power = surrender

>< Battle between agency and acceptance

+ - Newfound calm tested by full knowledge of evil

>< Carlos' deception vs Brad's

- + Nothing left to lose = power to save

>< Struggle transitioning between old life & new

+ - Actions to save family end in death

>< Brad in final battle to hold onto fam and crush cartel

- + From death to resurrection in new life

>< Struggle to start over

+ - Joy over family's safety, sting over never seeing them again

>< Loss of family to serve them & wider world
